





1. Given the following vectors:

$$A = -6i + 2j - 3k$$
 and $B = 4i - 3k$

$$|\vec{a}| = \sqrt{(-6)^2 + (2)^2 + (-3)^2} = 7$$

b) Find the magnitude of **B**. (5pts.)
$$|\vec{g}| = \sqrt{4^2 + (-3)^2} = 5$$

$$\vec{A} \cdot \vec{B} = A_{x}B_{x} + A_{y}B_{y} + A_{z}B_{z}$$

$$= (-6)(4) + 2(0) + (-3)(-3)$$

$$= -24 + 9 = -15$$

d) Find A x B (5pts.)
$$\overrightarrow{A} \times \overrightarrow{B} = |\widehat{1}| \widehat{1} |\widehat{1}|$$




